Pop-Up stands are a portable branded backdrop, which are compact for transportation and quick and easy to set up. Consisting of a collapsible frame, magnetic bars which fix onto the frame, and branded graphic panels that magnetise onto the frame.

Impact Pop Up stands are ideal for exhibitions, road shows, client presentations, retail display, or any venue where you need to promote your brand or company in a professional manner.

At Zoom our pop-up systems are known as the Impact range. Each model has its own unique features and advantages, so if its an Impact system its our quick build, portable pop-up system.



Sizes Explained

Pop Up Stands continue to be one of the exhibition industry's favourite displays. And yet if you are new to exhibiting the pop up terminology can sometimes be confusing.

3×3 Pop Up Stands are the most popular size of pop up display. But a 3×3 stand should not be confused with a stand that is 3m by 3m.

The most common sizes are 2x3, 3x3 and 4x3. This reference refers to the number of cells in the pop up frame.





Pop Up stands sizes are referred to by the number of squares that make up the frame. A 4x3 is made up of a frame four squares wide by 3 squares high.

Height Options

The most common frame sizes are 2x3, 3x3 and 4x3. The standard height of a three square high frame is around 2.2m.

Impact Xpress is available 1.85m high or 2.25m.



Warranty

Impact frames all come with a guarantee against manufacturers faults. Every frame part is individually replaceable. Damaged parts can be replaced easily without fuss.

This can often be done on-site, or can be sent back to us to carry out the repair.



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Transportation

Impact Pop Up stands can be supplied with the frame in a carry bag, and graphic panels in a cardboard drum. This is lightest weight option, and will easily fit in a small car.



However, often pop up stands need to be shipped by courier, where a more protective case is needed to prevent damage in transit.

We supply a range of secure and portable case options that transports your system safely and comfortably.

Cases have secure handles, wheels for portability and can even be used as podiums, with a simple counter top and graphic wrap around kit.



Euro Case

A rectangular wheeled case.

This is the lowest cost case option. Can also be used as a branded

podium, and is available with beech, white or black tabletop.



Zeus Case

Wheeled case, which has an oval shape.





The podium is completed with a tabletop available with a beech, white or black finish.

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Changing panels

Pop Up stands are produced with high impact graphic panels. Around half of the cost of an Impact stand is the hardware and the other half is the printed graphic panels.

Pop Up stands are so popular because new panels can be produced at a later date, to give a cost effective way of ensuring that your display system can be updated as your branding and products / services progress.

Artwork is created 1/4 size of the final system, therefore we recommend all images have a resolution of 320dpi at 1/4 size to give a final print resolution of at least 80dpi.

When sending a high resolution PDF please outline all fonts.

The majority of Impact stands have curved end panels. When creating artwork, please bear in mind that half of the panel wraps around the back of the frame out of front visibility.

How we create our panels

Whilst the quality of the frame will affect the durability and ease of set up, it's the graphic panel that a potential customer will look at.


There are a number of different materials that pop up stand companies use in the

production of a stand. These different materials can have a big effect on the overall look of the stand, and also the durability.

The best quality graphic panels are ones that have a laminate on the front, and a stoplight backing which sandwiches the paper print. The laminate protects the panel against damage when in use, and also stops the print from being worn over time from repeated use. The stoplight adds thickness to the panel, and prevents light from shining through the panel.

However, laminating and applying stoplight to a graphic panel requires skilled labour and a laminator machine which costs in the region of £10,000. So a lot of display stand producers have cut costs by using a one piece material which stops light from shining through, but doesn't have the laminate on the front.

Zoom display always uses the latest cutting edge technology to create our panels ensuring years of use with correct care.



The cost of our Impact pop up display systems, varies throughout the range. With Impact Xpress being the cheapest through to the Impact Plus which is the premium option.

Although all graphic panels are produced using the same material and process, it is the frame which influences the cost.

Differences are reflected by the materials used in the production of the frame, and the quality of the fittings which enable the graphic panels to magnetise to the frame.

The Impact Original and Plus, have higher quality panel fixings, which makes set up easier and quicker, with less adjustment needed to ensure overlapping images and text line up perfectly.
